What will be available at Go Live in the eCARE system

Nursing

- Latest set of Observations for in patients prior to transferring to wards

Doctors

- Patient clerking
- Patient dashboards including patient lists

EPMA

- Not being used in Endoscopy

Order Comms

- Favourite folders for commonly requested tests which can be tailored to clinician, specialty discipline or patient condition
- Electronic results endorsing, view results and document action taken
- Trend results
- Clinical messaging including transfer of patients results to another clinician
- Bloods ordered by Docs

PAS

- Automatic modifying of follow up appointments
- Batch Reschedule of multiple appointments from single clinic
- Offer Forms - to cancel appointments with correct logic reasons
- Logic to stop encounters being utilized more than once for first appointments
- Ward discharge requests for follow up appointments
- Order Comms requests for follow up appointments

What will not be available in the eCARE system at Go Live and will continue on paper as current process

- Will use paper patient admission form as current process from wards and day cases

- Discharge including electronic discharge through specialist software and handed to patient if appropriate, sent to GP's
- Paper report returned with patient
- Specialist bespoke software, Unisoft
- Consent
- WHO checklist

- No FP10 Outpatient Prescribing option. Use current process
- Medicines prescribed details on Unisoft as current process
- Updated PGD as current process

- ECG's requests but results not available electronically
- Paper request for tertiary hospitals
- Consent forms

- The ability to remove the existing encounter when rescheduling an appointment.
- Continue to use paper based diary
