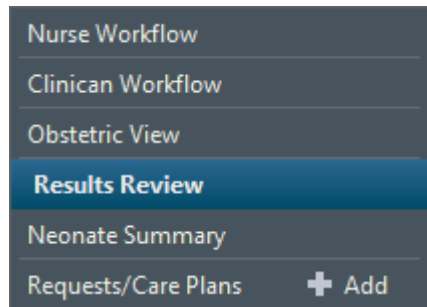


Blood Transfusion – viewing if blood & blood products are ready for collection.
